**DARWIN** Day 1 - Tuesday 16 July 2024 Meet the Tour escort & Torii guests this afternoon at the Novotel Darwin CBD. (Own arrangements to Darwin).

Day 2 - Wednesday 17 July Today we experience the history of WWII in Darwin. See the remnants of the war along the Darwin shoreline, aboard the Bombing of Darwin Cruise boat; visit the Royal Flying Doctor Service Tourist Facility, featuring the RFDS Story and the Bombing of Darwin on 19th February, 1942; and the **WWII Oil Storage Tunnels**, built to protect oil stored in Darwin from Japanese bombing.

Afterwards we enjoy lunch at the Trailer Boat Club, before our visit to the Darwin Military Museum, featuring the powerful Defence of Darwin Experience, which highlights the 1942 bombing raids.

Day 3 - Thursday 18 July **DARWIN** We transfer this morning to the perimeter of the RAAF Base Darwin, to view the aircraft of the exercise, departing and returning to the Base. Exercise Pitch Black 2024 is the RAAF's most significant International Engagement activity. The exercise will host over 2500 personnel and up to 100 aircraft from around the globe, are expected to attend including participants from Australia, France, Germany, Italy, Indonesia, India, Japan, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, South Korea, Spain, Thailand, UK, and the USA. (Participants are subject to change)

An afternoon visit to the Darwin Aviation Museum, displaying Darwin's aviation history and wartime experience, with aircraft including the legendary Boeing B52 G Stratofortress 92596 "Darwin's Pride", the only one in the Southern Hemisphere; a B-25 Mitchell Bomber (one of the few surviving in the world); the remnants of the Mitsubishi Zero gunned down during the first bombing of Darwin; the F-111C Strike Fighter; aircraft engines and rare amateur footage of the first air-raid in Darwin. Afterwards view the aircraft from the Pitch Black Exercise, as they provide an aerial display at the Mindil Beach Sunset Markets.

Day 4 - Friday 19 July **DARWIN** Morning visit to Charles Darwin National Park to view the World War II – era concrete bunkers, memorabilia displays & the sweeping views of Darwin's skyline. Travelling south along the Stuart Highway, we stop at **Strauss Airfield,** a base for P40 Kittyhawk and Spitfire fighter squadrons & one of the last surviving and most intact WWII pursuit fighter installations in northern Australia, before visiting the Adelaide River War Cemetery. A stop for lunch at the Adelaide River Inn "303 Bar", where standing proudly is "Charlie" the Buffalo, made famous by Mick Dundee in the movie Crocodile Dundee. Returning to Darwin we stop at Coomalie Creek airfield, a RAAF airfield built in 1942. The first unit stationed at the airfield was No. 31 Squadron, equipped with Bristol Beaufighters. The last Australia-based operational RAAF mission of World War II departed from Coomalie Creek. The airfield came under attack by the Japanese 6 times during 1942-1943.
